Transparency

Transparency of data about the electricity market

Transparency is essential for achieving a functional, efficient, liquid and competitive wholesale electricity markets. It refers to the availability and disclosure of all relevant information to all market participants and is a prerequisite of non-discriminatory market functioning.

As a transmission system operator, EMS comply with Regulation (EC) No. 714/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Energy Law ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia" No. 57/11, 80/11-amendment, 93/12 and 124/12), which requires the publication of data about the electricity market in Serbia.

EMS will publish all relevant data related to network availability, network access and network use, including a report on where and why congestion exists, the methods applied for managing the congestion and the plans for its future management.

On JP EMS Transparency platform the following data were published till now:

Network capacity: data regarding net and available transfer capacity: month ahead and year ahead.

Explicit auctions: daily, monthly and yearly auctions (ATC, results, ...).

Data can be viewed as table and XML. Also, data can be downloaded in following formats: XML, CSV and JSON.

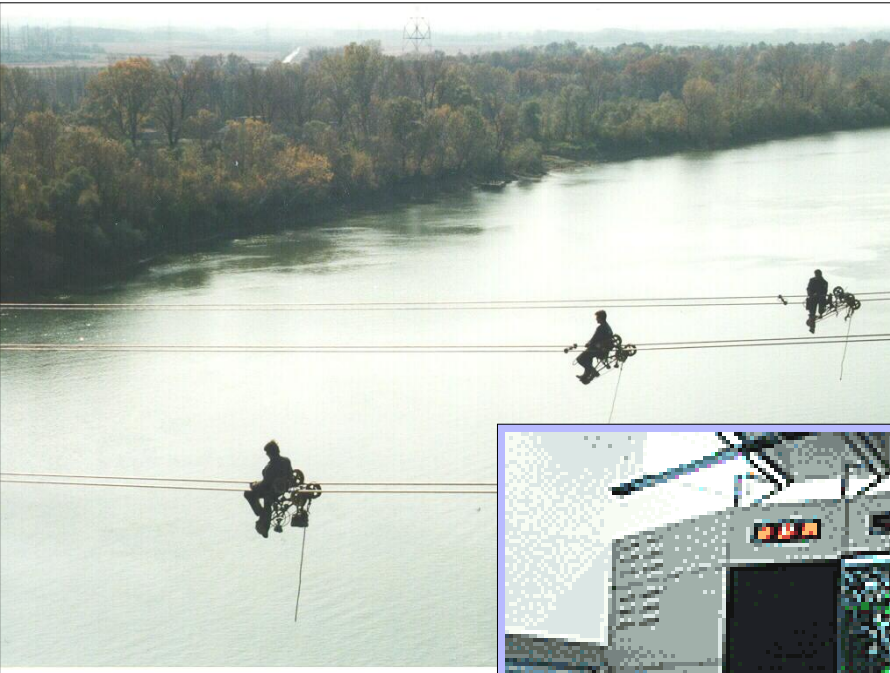
